Governor Helps Launch Constitution Week

Cayman's first Constitution Week was launched on Thursday, 1 July 2010 at Government House when His Excellency the Governor, Mr. Duncan Taylor, CBE, hosted an evening to introduce members of Constitutional Commissions and other constitutional bodies. He announced that Regional Managing Partner of Ernst & Young, Mr. Dan Scott would head the Judicial and Legal Services Commission before introducing him. The members of that commission would be announced shortly, he told the gathering that also included members of the judiciary, senior government officials and former ministers.
